

# Free Wednesday Addams Amigurumi Crochet Pattern

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A Free Crochet Pattern by DotComWomen.com



## Materials

- Yarn: Medium (4) – Black (dress, hair, shoes), White (collar, socks), Skin tone (head, hands, legs)
- Hook: 2.5 mm–3.0 mm (tight fabric recommended)
- Notions: 8 mm safety eyes (or black yarn to embroider), fiberfill stuffing, yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker, black embroidery thread

## Abbreviations (US Terms)

MR – Magic Ring

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

inc – increase (2 sc in same st)

dec – invisible decrease (sc 2 together)

sl st – slip stitch

st(s) – stitch(es)

Notes: Work in continuous rounds unless stated. Use a stitch marker. Gauge is not critical, but fabric should be tight so stuffing doesn't show.

## Head

R1: MR, 6 sc (6)

R2: inc in each st (12)

R3: (sc, inc) × 6 (18)

R4: (2 sc, inc) × 6 (24)

R5: (3 sc, inc) × 6 (30)

R6–R12: sc around (30)

R13: (3 sc, dec) × 6 (24)

R14: (2 sc, dec) × 6 (18) – Insert safety eyes between R9–R10, ~6 sts apart.

R15: (sc, dec) × 6 (12)

R16: dec around (6). Fasten off, close opening. Stuff firmly.

## Body

R1: MR, 6 sc (6)

R2: inc in each st (12)

R3: (sc, inc) × 6 (18)

R4: (2 sc, inc) × 6 (24)

R5–R7: sc around (24)

R8: change to White (collar edge), sc around (24)

R9: sc around (24)

R10: change to Black, sc around (24)

R11–R14: sc around (24)

R15: (2 sc, dec) × 6 (18)

R16: (sc, dec) × 6 (12)

R17: sc around (12). Fasten off. Stuff.

## Arms (Make 2)

R1: With Skin, MR, 6 sc (6)

R2–R3: sc around (6)

R4: change to Black (sleeve), sc around (6)

R5–R7: sc around (6). Stuff lightly. Fasten off, leave tail to sew.

## Legs (Make 2)

R1: With Black (shoe), MR, 6 sc (6)

R2: inc in each st (12)

R3: (3 sc, dec) × 3 (9)

R4–R5: sc around (9)

R6: change to White (socks), sc around (9)

R7–R8: sc around (9)

R9: change to Skin, sc around (9)

R10–R12: sc around (9). Stuff. Fasten off, leave tail.

## **Hair Cap & Braids**

Hair Cap:

R1: MR, 6 sc (6)

R2: inc in each st (12)

R3: (sc, inc) × 6 (18)

R4: (2 sc, inc) × 6 (24)

R5: (3 sc, inc) × 6 (30)

R6–R8: sc around (30). Leave a long tail and sew to head.

Braids:

Cut multiple 30–35 cm strands. Attach along each side using latch-hook method. Divide into three sections per side, braid tightly, and knot ends.

## **Assembly**

- 1) Sew head to body opening at R17. Add a little extra stuffing as you close.
- 2) Attach arms to sides of body spanning R11–R12.
- 3) Attach legs evenly under body; ensure the doll stands or sits flat.
- 4) Embroider thin straight eyebrows and a tiny horizontal mouth with black thread.
- 5) Add white felt collar triangles if you prefer a sharper look. Embroider tiny black buttons down the front.

## Hair Cap Diagram

### Hair Cap: Increase Map (work in continuous round)

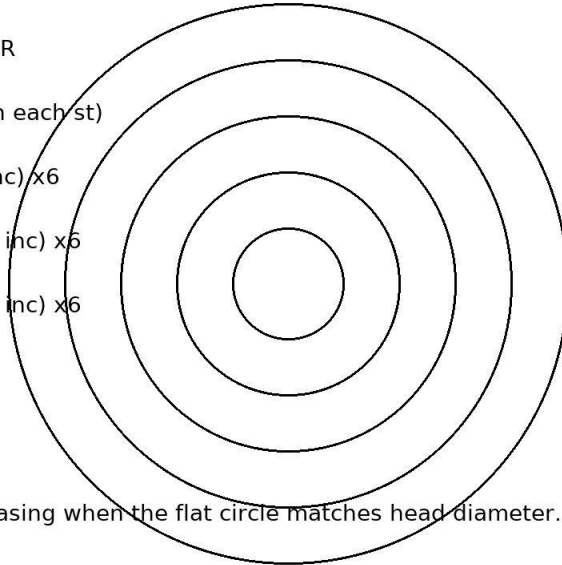
R1: 6 sc in MR

R2: 12 (inc in each st)

R3: 18 (sc, inc) x6

R4: 24 (2 sc, inc) x6

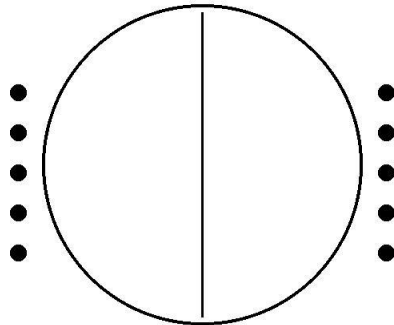
R5: 30 (3 sc, inc) x6



Tip: Stop increasing when the flat circle matches head diameter.

## Braids Diagram

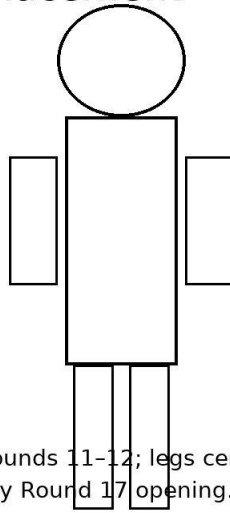
### Braids: Placement & Attachment



Latch-hook strands along the side seam (behind ears), then braid tightly and secure ends with a knot.

## Limb Placement Diagram

### Assembly: Limb Placement



Attach arms at Body Rounds 11-12; legs centered under body.  
Sew head firmly to Body Round 17 opening.

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
